

ORDINANCE NO. 2453

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH OREGON IRON WORKS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A STEEL FIRE ESCAPE FOR THE CITY FIRE HALL FOR DRILL PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids for the construction of a steel fire escape for the City Fire Hall, City of Albany, and

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time therein set forth, and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Council of the City of Albany

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Oregon Iron Works for the construction of a steel fire escape for the City Fire Hall in the sum of \$631.00, and

By this Ordinance does hereby ratify any action heretofore taken as herein provided.

Inasmuch as the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
