

ORDINANCE NO. 2548

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH E. V. MARTIN, CONTRACTOR, FOR SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Recorder did heretofore advertise for bids for sidewalk improvements along the Southside of Queen Avenue between Liberty Street and a point approximately 512 feet West of Liberty Street and along the West side of Liberty Street from Queen Avenue to a point approximately 560 feet South of Queen Avenue, and,

WHEREAS, said bids were received and duly opened at the time therein set forth, and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Council of the City of Albany


THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and City Manager of the City of Albany are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with E. V. Martin, contractor for the improvement of sidewalks along the South side of Queen Avenue from Liberty Street to a point approximately 512 feet West of Liberty Street and along the West side of Liberty Street from Queen Avenue to a point 560 feet South of Queen Avenue in the total sum of \$1,844.97, according to the bid submitted.

Inasmuch as the passage of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.
