ORDINANCE NO. 2606

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING FOR THE CITY OF ALBANY, LINN COUNTY, OREGON, THE 1955 EDITION OF THE PACIFIC COAST BUILDING OFFICIALS CONFERENCE, UNIFORM BUILDING CODE INCLUDING VOLUMES 1 AND 2 AND THE LEGISLATIVE SECTIONS AND APPENDIX ATTACHED THERETO, AND ALL SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS THERETO, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2161, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Uniform Building Code, 1955 Edition, prepared and adopted by the Pacific Coast Building Officials Conference, of 124 West 4th Avenue, Los Angeles, California, contained in Volumes 1 and 2 and including the legislative sections and appendix attached thereto and all subsequent amendments thereto be, and the same is hereby adopted, accepted, passed and approved as the building code in and for the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon.

Section 2: That Ordinance No. 2499 passed by the Council on September 23, 1953 and approved by the Mayor September 23, 1953 and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3: Whereas it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Albany that this ordinance shall become immediately operative, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.
