

ORDINANCE NO. 1789

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF DENVER STREET, ALSO KNOWN AS SHERMAN STREET, NORTH OF THE INTERSECTION OF TWENTY-EIGHTH AVENUE.

Whereas, the Council of the City of Albany did, by Resolution No. 460 at the Council meeting on the 12th day of March 1958, set the hour as 7:15 p.m. Pacific Standard Time on April 23, 1958, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of Denver Street, also known as Sherman Street, North of the intersection of Twenty-Eighth Avenue, more particularly described in the said Resolution and did in the said Resolution direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of said proposed vacation as required by law, and

Whereas, notice has been posted and published as required by law and in the said Resolution the people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows, and

Whereas the said hearing, on the 23rd day of April 1958 was duly held and no remonstrance having been filed with the City Recorder and no persons appearing objecting to the proposed vacation

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a portion of Denver Street, also known as Sherman Street, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

All of the portion of Denver Street, also known as Sherman Street, which lies North of the intersection of 28th Avenue and between Lots 19 and 2, and 18 and 1 of the First Addition to Rodgers Acres, Linn County, Oregon.

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street in the City of Albany.
