

ORDINANCE NO. 2790

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE CHARLES C. CURRY PROPERTY, CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 14th day of May 1958, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, did duly pass Ordinance No. 2782 wherein it was provided that a public hearing would be held on the 11th day of June, 1958, concerning the advisability of annexing the Charles C. Curry Property, contiguous to the City of Albany, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, the hearing was duly held on the 11th day of June 1958, and at that time the Council determined that notices of hearing had been duly given as provided in the said Ordinance and pursuant to the terms of 222.120 ORS, and

WHEREAS, the Council after the said hearing determined that the said Charles C. Curry Property be annexed to the City of Albany, and the consent of the property owners have been filed giving their consent for the said annexation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following described property be and it is hereby annexed to the City of Albany to-wit:

Beginning at a point South 1°35' East 299.4 feet from the Northwest corner of the South half of the Leander C. Burkhart D. L.C. No. 50 in T. 11 S., R. 3 W of the Willamette Meridian, which point is on the centerline of Geary Street and on the Southerly right-of-way line of the Southern Pacific Railroad; thence South 72°27' West 540.42 feet along the said Southerly railroad right-of-way line; thence North 17°33' West 60 feet to the Northerly line of said railroad right-of-way; thence South 72°27' West 590 feet, more or less, to a point which is North 72°27' East 172.93 feet from the East line of a County Road known as Oak Drive; thence North 5°40' West, parallel to the East line of the said Oak Drive, to a point on the South line of a County Road running Northeasterly from Oak Drive to Geary Street, said point also being North 79° East 170 feet from the Southeast corner of the intersection of the County Road and Oak Drive; thence South 79° West 170 feet to the Southeast corner of the intersection of the County Road and Oak Drive; thence North 5°40' West 181 feet, more or less, along the Easterly line of Oak Drive to a point 121 feet from the Northeast corner of the intersection of the said County Road and Oak Drive; thence Easterly to the Northwest corner of Lot 5, Block 2, Price's 2nd Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon; thence Easterly to the Northeast corner of said Lot 5; thence Easterly to the Northwest corner of Lot 8, Block 1, Price's 2nd Addition; thence Southerly 15 feet along the West line of said Lot 8; thence in a Southeasterly direction to a point which is South 79° West 15 feet and Northerly 28 feet, parallel with the West line of Block 1, Price's 2nd Addition, from the Southeast corner of Lot 7, Block 1, Price's 2nd Addition; thence Southerly 28 feet, parallel with the West line of said Block 1, to the Southerly line of said Block 1; thence Easterly along the Southerly line of said Block 1, to the centerline of Geary Street; thence South 1°35' East along the centerline of Geary Street to the point of beginning.

Section 2: Whereas, it is in the betterment of the public health, interest, safety and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Albany that this matter of annexation of the property described herein be disposed of at the earliest possible moment, and, should the same be annexed, that the City facilities be made available to this property, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
