

ORDINANCE NO. 3009

TITLE: An Ordinance amending Section 12 of Ordinance No. 2751 as pertains to the use of loading zones and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AMENDMENT

Section 12 of Ordinance No. 2751 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 12: USE OF LOADING ZONE. No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle for any purpose or length of time other than for the expeditious unloading and delivery or pick up and loading of materials, freight or passengers in any place designated as a loading zone during the hours when the provisions applicable to loading zones are in effect. The stopping, standing or parking of a vehicle in an unmetered loading zone in excess of 15 minutes shall be prima facie evidence of a violation of the use of loading zone.

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that this Ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
