

ORDINANCE NO. 3217

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF 16<sup>th</sup> AVENUE IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 893, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1965, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on October 13<sup>th</sup>, 1965, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue, as hereinafter described, and did direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1965, has duly been held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue from Lafayette Street to its Easterly termination approximately 60 feet East of Lafayette Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street and thoroughfare in the City of Albany, Oregon.

Section 2: That the City of Albany does reserve an easement over the Northerly 12 feet of said vacated street for walkway purposes.
