

ORDINANCE NO. 3337

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A TWELVE FOOT DEDICATED SIDEWALK STRIP LOCATED IN BEAM'S SUPPLEMENTAL PLAT TO HOLLYWOOD ACRES, CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 3331, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 1046, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 8th day of November, 1967, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on December 13, 1967, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a twelve foot dedicated sidewalk strip in Beam's Supplemental Plat to Hollywood Acres, as hereinafter described, and did direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 13th day of December, 1967, was duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 3331, City of Albany Ordinances, is hereby repealed.

Section 2: That the twelve foot dedicated sidewalk strip more particularly described as follows:


Beginning at the Northeast corner of Lot 1, Block 6, Beam's Supplemental Plat to Hollywood Acres, Linn County, Oregon; thence North 12 feet to the South boundary of Block 14, Hollywood Acres; thence West 118.72 feet to the East boundary of South Main Street; thence South 12 feet along the South Main Street to the Northwest corner of Lot 1, Block 6, said Beam's Supplemental Plat to Hollywood Acres, thence East 118.72 feet to the point of beginning. be and the same is hereby vacated as a public sidewalk in the City of Albany, Oregon.

Section 3: That the City of Albany does reserve an easement for utility purposes over the east ten (10) feet of the vacated sidewalk strip and retains the right to go upon the premises and install, replace or repair sewers, water lines, or other public utilities.

Section 4: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
