

ORDINANCE NO. 3357

AN ORDINANCE VACATING WEST TENTH AVENUE BETWEEN BROADWAY STREET AND LAWRIDGE STREET,
CITY OF ALBANY, LINN COUNTY, OREGON.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany did, by adoption of Resolution No. 1095, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 22nd day of May, 1968, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on June 26, 1968, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of West Tenth Avenue between Broadway Street and Lawridge Street, as hereinafter described, and did direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 26th day of June, 1968, was duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the portion of a street more particularly described as follows:

All that portion of Tenth Avenue between the East line of Broadway Street and the West line of Lawridge Street; except five feet on each side of the center line of said street; this property being retained as a public walk-way. Also, the City of Albany does reserve an easement for utility purposes over and under the said vacated street and does retain the right to go upon the premises to install, replace or repair sewers, water lines or other public utilities.

be and the same is hereby vacated as a public street in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon.
