

ORDINANCE NO. 3441

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2751 BY THE ADDITION THERETO OF SECTION 1A, ADOPTION OF MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS PASSED BY THE 1969 OREGON LEGISLATURE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: AMENDMENT - ADOPTION OF 1969 LAWS.

Ordinance No. 2751 is amended by the addition thereto of Section 1B to read as follows:

"Section 1B: ADOPTION OF MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS - 1969 LEGISLATURE.
The following enumerated motor vehicle laws of the State of Oregon, together with all acts and amendments applicable to cities which are now or hereafter enacted, are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this Ordinance. Oregon Revised Statutes 483.202, Oregon Revised Statutes 483.206, Oregon Revised Statutes 483.308, Oregon Revised Statutes 483.430, Oregon Revised Statutes 483.423, Oregon Revised Statutes 483.456, Oregon Revised Statutes 483.457, Oregon Revised Statutes 483.538, Oregon Revised Statutes 483.634, Oregon Revised Statutes 484.010, also House Bill No. 1475 as adopted and enacted into law the same pertaining to traffic safety, defining careless driving and permitting a police officer to arrest for such violation committed in his presence."

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE.

WHEREAS, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany requires that this Ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become in full force immediately upon final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
