

ORDINANCE NO. 3579

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A TEN FOOT UTILITY EASEMENT LYING ALONG THE NORTH LINE OF LOTS 21 AND 22, BLOCK 3, D. F. LENTZ SUBDIVISION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 1343, City of Albany Resolutions, at the council meeting held on the 28th day of July, 1971, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on the 8th day of September, 1971, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of utility easement lying along the North line of Lots 21 and 22, Block 3, D. F. Lentz Subdivision, City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, as hereinafter described, and did direct the City Recorder to publish and post notice of the said proposed vacation as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 8th day of September, 1971, has been duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That a ten-foot utility easement lying along the North line of Lots 21 and 22, Block 3, D. F. Lentz Subdivision, as platted and recorded in Book 14, Page 24, Linn County Plat Records, City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2: EMERGENCY CLAUSE

Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency ;is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor of the City of Albany.


