

ORDINANCE NO. 3801

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING SOCIAL GAMBLING EXCEPT IN HOMES AND CHARITABLE, FRATERNAL OR RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATIONS IN THE CITY OF ALBANY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Social Games as defined in House Bill No. 3327 approved by the Governor and effective May 4, 1974 are hereby totally prohibited in the city of Albany except that persons in homes, Charitable, Fraternal and Religious Organizations may engage in social games where no income is realized from the games.

SECTION 2. It is hereby adjudged and declared that the existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health and safety of the people of the City of Albany and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
