

ORDINANCE NO. 3839

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3594, SEGREGATING THE LIEN OF GEORGE KLUTKE ON PROPERTY DESCRIBED AS ST-71-6, THURSTON STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, George Klutke (c/o Dick Draper) was assessed for street improvement - Thurston Street under Ordinance No. 3594 for the following properties:

WHEREAS, the above described properties have been platted into two parcels respectively, now, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That portion of Ordinance No. 3594 which assessed properties as set forth in the attached description in the total amount of \$2,496.16 is hereby amended to segregate the liens thereon in the following manner.

Section 2: The City Recorder is hereby directed to make the necessary entries on the Lien Docket of the City of Albany to segregate the said liens as above set forth.

Section 3: Inasmuch as it is deemed necessary for the public health, peace and safety of the citizens of the City of Albany, that the provisions shall be immediately operative, it is hereby declared that an emergency exists and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
