

TITLE: AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING AND NOTICE THEREOF THEREOF TO CONSIDER WITHDRAWING CERTAIN ANNEXED TERRITORY FROM THE ALBANY RURAL FIRE DISTRICT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

RECITALS: WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interest of the City of Albany and the territory annexed by Ordinance No. 3881 that such territory be withdrawn from the Albany Rural Fire District; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany desires to obtain further citizens' opinion on the subject of withdrawal as directed by state law to obtain such opinion; now, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: PUBLIC HEARING.

A public hearing on the question of withdrawing annexed territory from the Albany Rural Fire District shall be held on the 11th day of February, 1976 at 7:15 o'clock p.m. at the City Hall of the City of Albany.

Section 2: NOTICE.

The City Recorder shall cause notice of the hearing to be published once each week for two (2) successive weeks prior to the day of the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation within the city. The City Recorder shall also cause notice of this hearing to be posted in four (4) public places within the city for a like period of time.

Section 3: EMERGENCY.

Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
