AN ORDINANCE VACATING A 60 FOOT RIGHT-OF-WAY OF MONTEITH SOUTHERN ADDITION, BLOCK 99, KNOWN AS BROADALBIN STREET BETWEEN ELEVENTH STREET AND PACIFIC BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany, did, by adoption of Resolution No. 1969, City of Albany Resolutions, at the Council meeting held on the 14th day of June, 1978, set the hour of 7:15 p.m. o'clock on the 12th day of July, 1978, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of Monteith Southern Addition, Block 99, known as Broadalbin Street between Eleventh Street and Pacific Boulevard, and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law, and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 12th day of July, 1978, has been duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the Council being fully informed,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:


That a 60 foot right-of-way of the Monteith Southern Addition, Block 99, known as Broadalbin Street between Eleventh Street and Pacific Boulevard be vacated subject to the following conditions:

1. All maintenance and access easements necessary for the underground sanitary sewer and natural gas lines be granted.
2. The improvements (paving of this 60 foot right-of-way) shall be made within the next 60 days (dated from July 12, 1978).
