

ORDINANCE NO. 4493

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT PORTION OF 25TH AVENUE SW WHICH IS LOCATED WEST OF THE ALBANY-SANTIAM CANAL AND EAST OF THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC RAILROAD TRACKS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany did by adoption of Resolution No. 2315, City of Albany Resolutions, at the council meeting held on the 10th day of March, 1982, set the hour of 7:15 pm o'clock on the 14th day of April, 1982, as the time for hearing of objections to the proposed vacation of a portion of 25th Avenue SW which is located west of the Albany-Santiam Canal and east of the Southern Pacific railroad tracks as described on the attached legal description; and

WHEREAS, the said notice has been posted and published as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the said hearing on the 14th day of April, 1982, has been duly held and parties were given an opportunity to be heard and the council being fully informed.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That a portion of 25th Avenue SW located west of Albany-Santiam Canal and east of the Southern Pacific railroad tracks as described on the attached legal description is hereby vacated.

Section 2: Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, safety, and health of the City of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
