

ORDINANCE NO. 4983

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE 10.08.090, GENERAL DISCHARGE PROHIBITIONS, AND 10.12.030, REGULATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Albany Municipal Code 10.08.090, General Discharge Prohibitions, is hereby amended to read as follows:

10.08.090(3) PH. Any wastewater having a pH less than 6.0 or greater than ~~9.0~~ 10.0, or wastewater having any other corrosive property capable of causing damage or hazard to structures, equipment, and/or personnel of the POTW.

Section 2: Albany Municipal Code 10.12.030, Regulations, is hereby amended to read as follows:


10.12.030(1)(c). Any wastewater having a pH less than six (6.0) or greater than ~~nine (9.0)~~ ten (10.0), unless the treatment works is specifically designed to accommodate such wastewater, or wastewater having any corrosive property capable of causing damage or hazard to structures, equipment, and/or personnel of the City.

Section 3. Emergency Clause. It is hereby adjudged and declared that the existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Albany, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect when signed by the Mayor.
