

ORDINANCE NO. 5047

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ALBANY MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 7.12 IMMORAL PRACTICES, SPECIFICALLY BY REPEALING SECTIONS 7.12.090, SOLICITATION OF DRINKS AND 7.12.100, PEEPING TOM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Albany established Albany Municipal Code Section 7.12.090, Solicitation of Drinks in 1958 (Ordinance 2823) in response to the large number of soldiers from Camp Adair. This situation no longer exists.

WHEREAS, the City of Albany established Albany Municipal Code Section 7.12.100 Peeping Tom in 1958 (Ordinance 2823) forbidding any person other than the lawful occupant of property to look into or be found loitering around or within view of any window or door with the intent of looking through such window or door. There are several other State statutes and municipal codes that are more appropriate charges for this crime.

WHEREAS, both of these codes are outdated and are no longer necessary.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Albany Municipal Code Chapter 7.12 Immoral Practices, specifically Sections 7.12.090, Solicitation of Drinks and 7.12.100, Peeping Tom are hereby repealed.

~~7.12.090 Solicitation of drinks. No female person shall frequent, loiter or be employed in any tavern, cabaret or night club for the purpose of soliciting a male person to purchase drinks. No proprietor of any such establishment shall allow the presence in such establishment of any person who violates the provisions of this section, provided, however, that this section does not apply to female persons regularly employed as barmaids and waitresses.~~


~~7.12.100 Peeping Tom. Except for the lawful occupant of property, no person shall look into or be found loitering around or within view of, any window or door with the intent of looking through such window or door.~~

Section 2. Emergency Clause. Inasmuch as this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the city of Albany, Oregon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist; and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council.
