

RESOLUTION No. 219

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has heretofore proceeded to open Pine Street from the Southerly boundary of Eighth Avenue to the center line of Ninth Avenue in the City of Albany, Oregon, in accordance with the provisions set forth in Chapter VIII, Art. I of the Charter of the City of Albany, Oregon, and did, on the 24th day of October, 1951, at a regular council meeting of the said council, adopt the report of the viewers determining the benefits and damages, if any thereby, to the effected property, and

WHEREAS, the said report of viewers assessed no damages nor benefits, and

WHEREAS, no appeal from the ordinance adopting the report of the viewers has properly been perfected in accordance with the procedure defined in Chapt. VIII, Art. I, Sec. 185, and

WHEREAS, by virtue of the report of the said viewers, there is no need for the levy of assessments for benefits, nor the drawing of warrants for damages:

BE IT RESOLVED:

That Pine Street, from the southerly line of Eighth Avenue to the Center line of Ninth Avenue, being more particularly described as follows:

A 66' street in width, being 33' in width on either side of the center line thereof, said center line being described as follows;

Beginning at the intersection of the center line of Pine Street in the City of Albany, projected southerly with the southerly line of Eighth Avenue in said City of Albany and from said point running south 9 degrees 8 feet east along the extended projection of the center line of said Pine Street southerly 237.25 feet to an iron rod in the center of Ninth Avenue in City of Albany projected Easterly;

is hereby declared to be opened for the public use and benefit as a street of this City.
