

R E S O L U T I O N N O. 453

WHEREAS, an investigation has been held by the State Highway Department of the State of Oregon and the Police Department of the City of Albany covering restricted parking in certain areas on public streets, and

WHEREAS, after investigations were made, the matter was referred to the Parking Commission of the City of Albany and their recommendations were that parking be restricted in certain areas and parking re-established in other areas with the placement of meters in areas that have formerly been restricted to parking, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the common council of the City of Albany:

Section 1:

That area formerly designated for restricted parking in front of Midway Grocery on the south side of Highway 99, immediately west of the intersection of Pine Street in front of Midway Grocery be re-established as an authorized parking area.

Section 2:

That parking meters be replaced on the north side of Second Avenue immediately west of the intersection of Second Avenue and Ellsworth Streets.

Section 3:

There shall be restricted parking and that no parking shall be allowed from the west edge of the Midway Market located at the corner of Pacific Boulevard and Pine Streets from the west edge of said market in a southwesterly direction for a distance of forty (40) feet on the south side of Pacific Boulevard. That there shall be no parking in the first parking space west of the driveway off of Pacific Boulevard into Erickson's Market for a distance of twenty-two (22) feet.

Section 4:

That there shall be restricted parking during the hours of 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. in the following areas and that these areas shall be designated tow-away zones for vehicles found parked in these restricted areas during the hours of 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.


The areas so restricted are:

The first three (3) metered spaces on the south side of First Avenue east of Ellsworth at the intersection of First and Ellsworth Streets;

The first metered space on the east side of Ellsworth Street south of the intersection of Ellsworth Street and First Avenue;

The metered spaces on the north side of Second Avenue immediately west of the intersection of Second Avenue and Ellsworth Street.
