

RESOLUTION NO. 1431

(Establishment of Taxicab fares under Section 6 of Ordinance No. 2334)

WHEREAS, Section 6 of Ordinance No. 2334 as amended provides that taxicab fares shall be established by Resolution of the Council of the City of Albany, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1200 was adopted on the 10th day of September 1969, establishing taxicab fares, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that said fares fixed by Resolution No. 1200 be revised, and to accomplish this, Resolution No. 1200 should be repealed, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Albany that the following fares are hereby established for taxicabs operating within the City of Albany:

Sixty cents (\$0.60) for the first one-fourth mile

Ten cents (\$0.10) for each one-fourth mile after the first one-fourth mile

Twenty cents (\$0.20) for each additional passenger over the age of twelve years

One dollar (\$1.00) charged on trip cancellation

Six dollars (\$6.00) per hour for waiting time

Twenty-five cents (\$0.25) for each trunk

One dollar (\$1.00) minimum for trips between midnight and six a.m.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 1200 is hereby repealed.
