

RESOLUTION NO. 2661

WHEREAS, the Recreation Task Force, a joint effort by the City of Albany, GAPS District, LBCC, Boys' & Girls' Club, and the YMCA, has completed its study and is recommending that the current interagency recreation staff group be restructured as the Recreation Coordinating Committee; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this staff committee is to provide administrative support to the Community Recreation Commission; and

WHEREAS, establishing this cooperative organizational structure will greatly assist recreation service providers to ensure a balanced recreational program for the entire Albany community through an efficient service delivery system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Recreation Coordinating Committee be jointly established by the Albany City Council, the Board of Education of GAPS and LBCC, and the Board of Directors of the YMCA and Boys' & Girls' Club. This Committee shall be composed of nine staff members responsible for their organization's recreation program including one representative of the City Parks & Recreation Department, Boys' & Girls' Club, YMCA, GAPS, LBCC, City Library, Albany Community Pool, private recreation businesses, and youth service agencies. The private business and youth service agency representatives shall be appointed by the voting members of the Community Recreation Commission.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Recreation Coordinating Committee shall provide administrative support to the Community Recreation Commission and shall be responsible for the following:

1. Continue cooperative efforts and avoid duplication among recreation service providers.
2. Ensure a balanced recreational program for the entire community.
3. Promote awareness of available recreation programs by providing up-to-date information about current activities.
4. Assist in developing written interagency policy and operating agreements for approval by the appropriate organizations.
5. Investigate feasibility of a centralized clearinghouse.
6. Other recreation issues as requested by the Community Recreation Commission.
