

RESOLUTION NO. 3148

WHEREAS, Waverly Drive from 36th Avenue southerly to Columbus Street, and, Columbus Street from the proposed intersection with Waverly Drive southerly to Oak Creek are unimproved to City standards; and


WHEREAS, Subsection 15.04.010 of the Albany Municipal Code requires the City Council to declare by resolution that it intends to make said improvements; and

WHEREAS, Linn County will participate in the cost of the Columbus Street improvement; and

WHEREAS, Assessments against benefitted properties would be utilized in conjunction with other funding sources to finance the portion of the project from the Southern Pacific Railroad southerly to Oak Creek,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council intends to make the improvements and hereby directs the City Engineer to make a survey of the improvements and file a written engineer's report with the City Recorder and further directs the Finance Director to prepare a financial investigation report with such reports to be in compliance with AMC Sections 15.040.020 and 15.040.030.
