

RESOLUTION NO. 3888

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF SUBMISSION OF A REQUEST TO ODOT FOR PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS AND A COMMITMENT TO OFFER A LOCAL MATCH.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) is seeking input from cities and counties in identifying sections of urban highways where improvements are needed for pedestrians and/or bicyclists; and

WHEREAS, staff has identified for submittal four pedestrian improvement projects on Highway 99E, Santiam Highway, Ellsworth and Lyon Streets, and Highway 20 north of the Willamette River; and

WHEREAS, approval of these requests would result in improved pedestrian safety; and


WHEREAS, total project costs for each project will not exceed \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, the likelihood of approval of these requests would be improved if a local match of up to 10 percent of total project costs is offered by the City.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany approves and endorses the submittal of four requests to the Oregon Department of Transportation for the purpose of constructing pedestrian improvements at locations on Highway 99E, Santiam Highway, Ellsworth and Lyon Streets, and Highway 20 north of the Willamette River; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Albany offer a local match of up to 10 percent of total project costs, which City contribution will not exceed \$10,000 per approved project.
