

RESOLUTION NO. 4104

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION FOR TRANSPORTATION GROWTH MANAGEMENT GRANT FUNDS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE ALBANY STATE HIGHWAY 99E/US HIGHWAY 20 MULTI-MODAL CONNECTION PLAN AND COMMITMENT TO PROVIDE THE REQUIRED LOCAL MATCH.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Transportation and the Oregon Land Conservation and Development Department are administering the distribution of funds provided through the Transportation and Growth Management Grant Program to local jurisdictions for transportation and land use plans to implement state planning requirements; and

WHEREAS, a local match of 10.27 percent of the total project is required; and

WHEREAS, receipt of these funds will allow the City to develop a plan to upgrade the existing Oregon Highway 99E/US Highway 20 overpass in order to address LOS and capacity deficiencies and provide improved connections for all travel modes between Highway 99E/Highway 20, the Multi-Modal Rail Station and downtown Albany, and

WHEREAS, receipt of these funds will allow the City to develop a plan to address current transportation issues related to the existing Safeway grocery store at Highway 99E.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany approves and endorses the submittal of an application to the State of Oregon Transportation and Growth Management Grant Program for the purpose of developing an Albany State Highway 99E/US Highway 20 Multi-Modal Connection Plan; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Albany agrees to provide the required 10.27 percent local match from the City of Albany Transportation SDC Fund (03-412). The estimated amount of the local match is \$9,757.
