

A RESOLUTION PROPOSING THE ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY AT 1710 QUEEN AVENUE SW (AN-01-00) AND FORWARDING THE QUESTION OF ANNEXATION TO THE VOTERS' ON THE MAY 16, 2000 BALLOT.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY resolves that the findings contained in Exhibit A (which consists of the complete staff report to the Albany City Council, including attachments, and dated February 28, 2000; File AN-01-00), and by this reference incorporated herein, are hereby adopted.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ALBANY FURTHER RESOLVES that the 1710 Queen Avenue SW annexation, which would annex approximately 0.35 acres of property generally located south of Queen Avenue SW, west of Broadway Street, all within Linn County, Oregon, to be zoned RS-6.5 (Single Family Residential), is to be submitted to the legal voters of Albany, Oregon, for their approval or rejection pursuant to Albany City Charter Chapter 54 at an election to be held on May 16, 2000. This election will be conducted by mail-in ballots.

The ballot title of this measure and the form in which it shall be printed on the official ballot is as follows.

CAPTION: A MEASURE PROPOSING ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY AT 1710 QUEEN AVENUE SW

QUESTION: Shall the 0.35-acre property adjoining Queen Avenue be annexed?

SUMMARY: Approval of this measure would annex approximately 0.35 acres to the City of Albany. The property to be annexed is located at 1710 Queen. Upon annexation, the property would be zoned RS-6.5 (Single Family Residential).


The text of the measure is as follows:

The following described real property, all located in Linn County, Oregon, shall be annexed to the City of Albany upon obtaining a favorable majority vote of the people.

The property at 1710 Queen Avenue SW, shown on Linn County Assessor Map 11S-04W-13BA, tax lot 3500, as described in Linn County, Oregon, Microfilm Deed Records, Volume 758, Page 551. The subject property containing 0.35 acres, more or less.

The City Recorder is authorized and directed to give notice of the submission of this question to the voters, including a true copy of the complete text and the ballot title for the measure in the form in which it shall be printed on the official ballot and any other information required by law to be published. That notice shall be published in not less than two successive and consecutive weekly issues of the *Albany Democrat-Herald*.
