

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ALBANY PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO APPLY FOR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT FROM THE OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE COX CREEK MULTI-USE PATH AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department is accepting applications for the Local Government Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany Parks and Recreation Department desires to participate in this grant program to the greatest extent possible as a means of providing needed park and recreation acquisitions, improvements and enhancements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Albany Parks & Recreation Commission, City Council, and staff have identified improvements at the Cox Creek Multi-Use Path as a high priority need in the City of Albany; and

WHEREAS, the project will construct a multi-use concrete path, that is handicap accessible, and is approximately 1,700 foot long, 10 foot wide. This path will connect the recently completed perimeter path around Waverly Lake to the Willamette Riverfront trail at the 164-acre Simpson Park.

WHEREAS, the applicant hereby certifies that the matching share for this application is readily available at this time in the Parks and Recreation SDC Fund; and

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the City of Albany Parks and Recreation Department be authorized to apply for a Local Government Grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department for the Cox Creek Multi-Use Path between Waverly Lake Park and the Willamette Riverfront trail at Simpson Park as specified above.
