

RESOLUTION NO. 4557

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ALBANY PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT TO ACCEPT A LOCAL GOVERNMENT GRANT FROM THE OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A SECTION OF THE WILLAMETTE RIVERFRONT MULTI-USE PATH AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE AGREEMENT, AND REPEALING RESOLUTION 4486.

WHEREAS, at the City Council meeting on April 11, 2001, the Albany City Council approved the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department in the amount of \$230,000 for the development of the Willamette Riverfront Multi-Use Path; and

WHEREAS, conditions of obtaining this grant include a local match of 50 percent; and

WHEREAS, receipt of these funds will allow the City to construct a multi-use, handicap-accessible concrete path, that is approximately .8 miles long and 8-10 feet wide. This path will connect Monteith Riverpark and Bowman Park, which connects to the existing 1.3-mile path in Simpson Park; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany accepts this Local Government Grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department in the amount of \$229,137.00 for development of the section of the Willamette Riverfront Multi-Use Path between Monteith Riverpark and Bowman Park.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute the agreements and conditions for acceptance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following account numbers shall be applied to the grant:
