

RESOLUTION NO. 4723

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A FEDERAL RECREATIONAL TRAILS PROGRAM GRANT FROM THE OREGON PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A MULTI-USE TRAIL AROUND THE OAK CREEK SUBDIVISION CONNECTING TO TELOH CALAPOOIA PARK.

WHEREAS, at the City Council meeting on February 13, 2002, the Albany City Council approved the submittal of a grant application to the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department in the amount of \$10,000 for the construction of a new trail around the Oak Creek subdivision connecting to Teloh Calapooia Park; and

WHEREAS, conditions of obtaining this grant include a local match of 20 percent; and


WHEREAS, a receipt of these funds will allow the City to develop a two-mile trail and trail head for equestrian, pedestrian, and bicycle use. Improvements will include a ten foot wide graded trail system, a gravel trail head, and signage; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Albany accepts this Federal Recreational Trails Program Grant from the Oregon Parks and Recreation Department in the amount of \$10,000 for the construction of a multi-use trail around the Oak Creek subdivision connecting Teloh Calapooia Park, approves the use of donated labor, provided by Oak Creek Park LLC in the amount of \$10,000 as the City of Albany's local match, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the agreements and conditions for their acceptance.
