

RESOLUTION NO. 5020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTIAL REMOVAL OF ON-STREET PARKING ON HILL STREET, FROM 10TH AVENUE TO QUEEN AVENUE, 20 FEET IN FRONT OF 1520 AND 1530 HILL ST SE, THE ENTIRE FRONTAGE OF 1605 HILL ST SE, AND 60 FEET SOUTH OF 19TH AVENUE ON WEST SIDE OF STREET.

WHEREAS, the Hill Street Rehabilitation project was authorized by Council; and

WHEREAS, removal of on-street parking on Hill Street is required to provide adequate space to stripe travel lanes, turn lanes, and bike lanes in each direction; and

WHEREAS, removal of all on-street parking on Hill Street from 10th Avenue to 12th Avenue is required to provide adequate space for travel lanes and bicycle lanes; and

WHEREAS, removal of on-street parking on the east side of Hill Street from 12th Avenue to 14th Avenue is required to provide adequate space for on-street parking in front of homes on the west side of Hill Street; and

WHEREAS, removal of on-street parking on Hill Street, 20-feet in front of both 1520 and 1530 Hill Street, and the entire frontage of 1605 Hill Street, is required to construct a curb choker mid-block between 14th and Queen Avenues; and

WHEREAS, removal of on-street parking on the west side of Hill Street, 60-feet south from 19th Avenue, is required to construct a curb bulb-out on Hill Street at the southwest corner of the 19th Avenue intersection.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Albany City Council does hereby direct the removal of on-street parking on both sides of Hill Street, from 10th to 12th Avenues; the east side of Hill Street from 12th to 14th Avenues; 20-feet in front of both 1520 and 1530 Hill Street SE; the entire frontage of 1605 Hill Street SE; and the west side of Hill Street, 60-feet south of 19th Avenue per the attached map labeled Exhibit A.

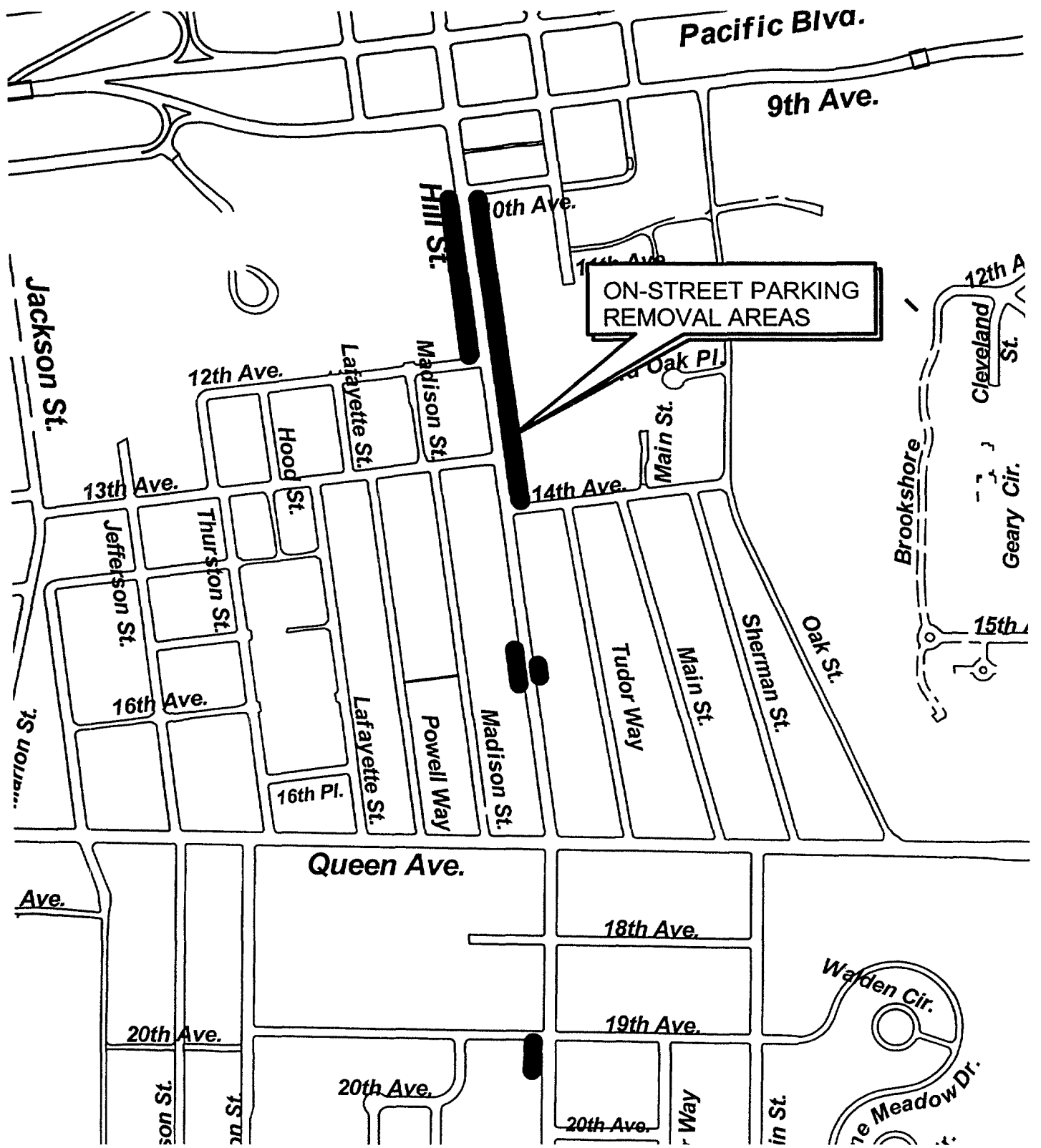


EXHIBIT A: HILL STREET ON-STREET PARKING REMOVAL
