

Ordinance No. 108  
 Relating to Minors wandering upon the Streets  
 between certain hours.

Be it ordained by the common Council of the City  
 of Albany.

Section I. That no minor shall be permitted to go abroad upon  
 or wander about the streets of the city between the hour of  
 nine o'clock P.M. and five o'clock A.M. of the following  
 morning, unless such minor shall have the permission  
 of his or her parent or guardian, or be accompanied by such  
 parent or guardian, or unless such minor shall have some  
 business upon such street or streets, and any such minor  
 who shall violate the provisions of this section shall be  
 deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction  
 before the Recorder shall be punished by a fine not less  
 than five nor more than fifty dollars or by impris-  
 onment not less than nor more than twenty five  
 days.

Section II This ordinance to take effect and be in force  
 from and after five days from its publication.
