

Ordinance No. 112.

And Ordinance to amend section 7 of an Ordinance entitled "Ordinance No. 46 Regulating the Fire Department of the City of Albany, passed February 12th 1878.

Be it ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany.

Section 11 That section seven (7) of Ordinance No. 46 regulating the Fire Department of the City of Albany, passed February 12th 1878, be amended so as to read as follows.

Section (7) Each steam engine company shall be allowed for ordinary expenses of company and apparatus the sum of \$700 per quarter; each hand engine company shall be allowed \$400 per quarter; each hook and ladder company shall be allowed \$300 per quarter; each independent hose company shall be allowed \$1500 per quarter; and the Board of Delegates shall be allowed \$500 per quarter.

Section (8) That this Ordinance take effect from and after five days after its publication.
