

Ordinance No. 145

Ord No. 145 An Ordinance Granting the Willamette Valley and Coast Railway Company a right of way for its railroad, side track, and switches over and across Water Street, and across Calapooia, Washington, Lyon, Baker, Montgomery, Jackson, Thurston, Jefferson and Water Streets in the City of Albany in the State of Oregon.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows.

Section 1. That the Willamette Valley and Coast Railroad Company is hereby granted the right of way for its railroad, side track and switches over and along Water Street in said City of Albany through and over the whole length thereof, commencing at the eastern boundary or terminus of Water Street the same being the eastern boundary line Hackleman's addition to said City of Albany and running thence westerly over and along said Water Street to the eastern boundary line of block of four (4) in the said City, and over and across Calapooia, Washington, Lyon, Baker, Montgomery, Jackson, Jefferson, Thurston and Water Streets in said City of Albany at such points or places as said Railroad Company may select or choose between First Street in said City and the Willamette River. Said Company and its successors in interest to have and enjoy said right of way as long as it shall use the same for the proper operation of said railroad side track and switches. Provided however that the Common Council of the City of Albany expressly reserves the right to prescribe the manner of such use at any and all times when the Common Council of said City may consider the public welfare of said City requires it to do so.

Section 2. Said Railroad Company as long as it uses said right of way over and across said Streets shall keep said side track and switches in good and safe repair, and said City hereby expressly reserves the right to establish grades on said Streets and prescribe the way and manner in which side and crosswalks shall be constructed at all crossing of such side tracks and switches.

the said side and crosswalks at such crossings to be built and kept in good repair at the expense of and by said Railroad Company. And said side track and switches shall be so constructed as not to obstruct travel on the streets which they pass.

Article 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
