Ordinance No. 197.

An Ordinance to provide for the material to be used in and the manner of building sidewalks from the north line of First street to the south line of Third street, between the east line of Washington street and the east line of Kalapooia street.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Sections That, the sidewalks hereafter constructed from the north line of First street, to the south line of Third street, and between the east line of Washington street and the east line of Kalapooia street shall be not less than (10) ten feet in width, and shall be constructed as follows: to wit:

There shall be five bearings four inches ~~wide~~ thick, by four inches wide laid on the ground or other suitable support, under each section of stringers at equal distances apart; there shall be laid on said bearings four tiers of stringers to be three inches thick by four inches wide, and eighteen feet long of red or yellow fir; said stringers to be placed on the bearing at suitable and equal distances apart, and well secured by being nailed to the bearings with thirty penny nails; the decking to be one and a half inch planking, squared edged and



evenly sawed, and not more than eight inches nor less than four inches wide; to be evenly and closely fitted together and well nailed to the stringers with twelve penny nails: all to be done in a good workman like manner (and to be placed on the established grade of the city, the incline of the walk to be not more than two inches to 24 feet running measure.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the mayor.

Passed by the Council the 10<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1889.
