

Ordinance No. 197.

an Ordinance to establish the grade
of Certain Streets in the City of Albany.

The People of the City of Albany
do ordain as follows:

Amended by Ordinance No. 213

Section 1: The established grade of the streets in the City of Albany, North of the Salem road, and extending from Main street, to the eastern boundary line of the City of Albany shall be in Conformity to the Survey and plat made by City Surveyor, W.B. Barr in the year 1870, and now on file in the Office of the Recorder of the City of Albany.

Section 2: Gutter of streets to be twelve (12) feet from line of blocks abutting thereon.

Section 3: The center of the finished street shall conform to the established grade, the gutter to be eight tenths ($8/10$) of a foot lower than the center of street, and there shall be not less than (6) six inches of gravel in the center of the street, and not less than (3) three inches of gravel at the edge of the gutter.

Section 4: All water mains or pipes laid in the streets, shall be placed not less than two (2) feet below the level of the surface or top of the street gutter.

Section 5: All gas mains, or pipes, laid in the streets, shall be placed not less than three (3) feet below the level of the

surface or top street gutter.

Section 6. The underground sewers, to be laid so that the top of the sewer shall be not less than (3) three feet below the level of the surface or top of street gutters.

Section 7. The top of sidewalks to be made even with the top of the grade of the center of the street, and shade trees planted, or set out to be located not less than (10) ten feet from the line of the block, abutting upon the street.

Section 8. No water, sewer, gas, or other pipes or mains shall be laid in the streets, by any person, or persons, or firm or corporation, for rent, hire, domestic or sanitary purposes without the right, or permit to lay such pipes or mains, is granted by a special Ordinance, passed by the Council of the city of Albany.

Section 9. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
