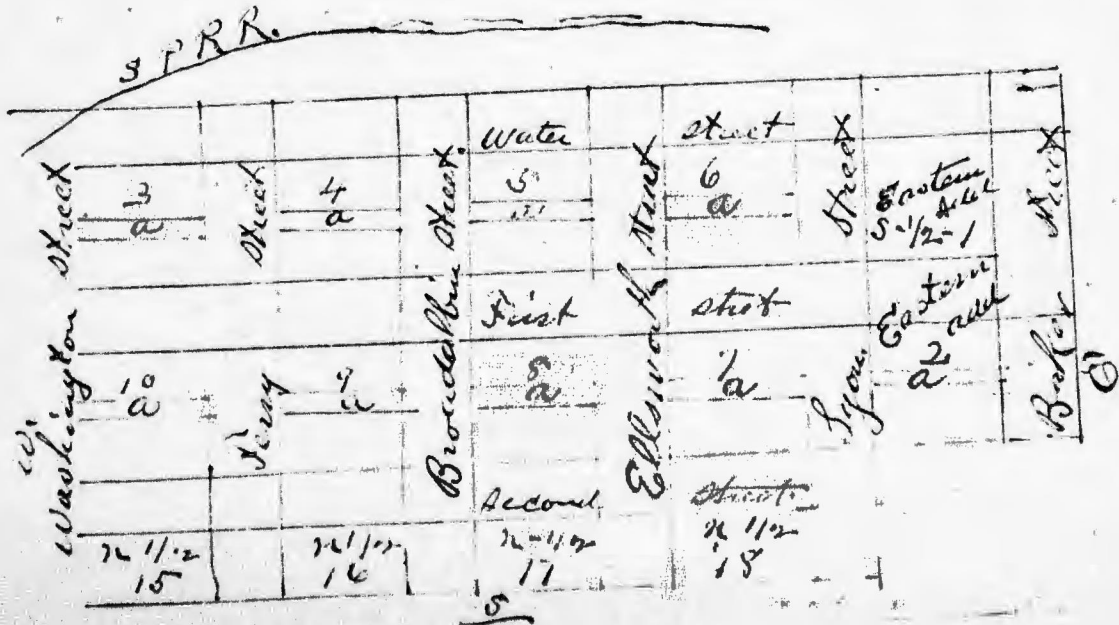

A Bill for an Ordinance to establish and define the fire limits of the City of Albany, and to repeal section 1. of Ordinance No 133, approved May 12th 1888, and Ordinance No-170, approved January 20th 1888, and Ordinance No-191, approved December 17th 1889, and to repeal all Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1: That all of Block No. three (3), four (4), five (5), six (6), seven (7), eight (8), nine (9), and ten (10) and the No half of Blocks No. fifteen (15), sixteen (16), seventeen (17), and eighteen (18), in the City of Albany, Oregon, and the South half of Block No. one (1) and all of Block No. two, in the Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, as shown by the plat hereunto attached and made a part of this Ordinance to wit:

Williamette River



And also according to the maps, plats, and surveys of said City now on file, and of records, in the Office of the County Recorder of Linn County, Oregon, he, and the same, are hereby declared to be within the fire limits of the City of Albany.

and the boundary lines of the several blocks, and parts of blocks, described in this ordinance, shall be the boundary lines of the five limits of said city of Albany.

Section 2: That, Section 1. of Ordinance No. 133, approved May 15th 1885, and all of Ordinance No. 170, approved January 25th 1887, and all of Ordinance No. 191, approved December 17th 1887, and all Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, in conflict with this Ordinance - be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3: That, this Ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force from, and after its approval by the Mayor.
