An Ordinance to declare an Assessment and fix and establish a lien for Street improvements on lot No. 1. in Block No. 18. in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, for the construction of a curbing and drain along Elsworth Street on the West side of and adjacent to said lot No. 1.

The People of the City of Albany Oregon do ordain as follows:
Sec. 1:- That whereas, on the 13th day of August 1901, a resolution was duly passed by the City Council of the City of Albany, declaring the intention to improve Elsworth Street on the East side thereof and adjacent to lot 1 in Block 18 in the said City of Albany, and caused due and legal notice thereof to be given, as required by law, and no objections or remonstrances being made to the proposed improvements, or the building of said curbing and drain, and thereafter on the 27th day of August 1901, duly passed an ordinance declaring the time and manner of constructing said curbing and drain and authorizing the Mayor and Recorder to enter into a contract to construct said curbing and drain, and thereafter the contract being duly made for the construction thereof, and the Superintendent of Streets having charge of said work as City Engineer, having reported that the costs of advertising and construction of said work, and other costs connected therewith, amount to the sum of \$20.31; that there be and is hereby assessed upon said lot No. 1. in block 18. in the City of Albany, the sum of \$20.31, and that said amount shall be a lien upon said lot until the full payment thereof.

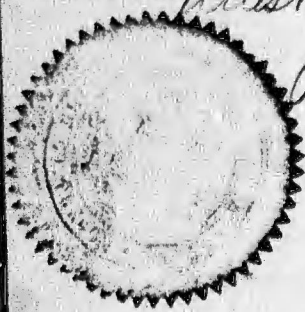
That the Recorder be and he is hereby directed to give notice to W. L. Vance the owner of said lot No. 1. of the assessment of said costs upon lot for the improvements so made, and if said sum is not paid within ten days, after giving of said notice that the Recorder of the City issue a warrant for the collection of said sum, directed to the City Marshall to forthwith levy upon and sell said lot as provided by law.
