

## ORDINANCE NO. 359

passed December 10 1901

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Dec. 10, 1901

An Ordinance declaring an assessment and to fix and establish a lien for sewer improvements on lots and parts of lots in Block No. 33, in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, for the construction, building and making of a lateral sewer through the center of said Block.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1: That whereas on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of July 1901 a resolution was duly passed by the City Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, declaring the intention of the said City, to build and construct a lateral sewer through the center of said block from the East side thereof to the West side, and connecting the same with the main sewer in Madison Street in the said City, of Albany, at the cost and expense of the several owners and holders of lots and parts of lots in said Block No. 33; and caused due and legal notice thereof to be given as required by law, and fixed the time for hearing objections thereto, and no objections or remonstrances being made to the proposed improvement, or the construction of said sewer, and thereafter on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of July 1901, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P.M. of said day at the Council Chambers in the City of Albany being the time and place fixed for hearing objections, if any, and no objections being made, the council duly passed an ordinance declaring the time and manner of constructing said sewer and authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of said City to enter into a contract to construct said sewer and authorizing the Recorder to advertise for bids therefor, and thereafter bids being received for the construction of said sewer, and a contract entered into and duly made for the construction thereof, and the City Engineer thereafter, having reported that the said work had been completed according to contract, and that the cost of advertising and the construction of said work and other costs connected therewith amounted to the sum of \$182.50

Section 2: That there be and is hereby assessed upon said lots and parts of lots in said block No. 33 in Hackleman's 2<sup>nd</sup> addition to the

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City of Albany Oregon, the several amounts as follows:—

To the Oregon and California Railroad Company owner of the Oregon and California Railroad Company's right of way in said Block, being 25.7 percent of said block	\$46.90
To Mrs. F. A. Haynes owner of lot 1 and that portion of lots 7 and 8 lying North of the Oregon and California Railroad Company's right of way in said block, being 25.5 percent of said block	46.17
To J. P. Wallace, <sup>owner</sup> of Lot 2 being 12.5 percent of said block	28.81
To M. Hess owner of lots 3 and 4 and that portion of lots 5 and 6, lying North of the Oregon and California Railroad Company's right of way in said block, being 29 percent of said block	52.93
To William Hoag owner of that portion of lots 5, 6 and 7, lying South of the Oregon and California Railroad Company's right of way in said block being 7.5 percent of said block	13.69
Total	\$182.50

That said work is done according to contract and the sewer completed and the several amounts assessed as hereinabove stated to the respective owners of lots and parts of lots in said block 33, and that the several amounts shall be a lien upon the property owned by the persons mentioned and named respectively until full payment thereof and that a record of said lien be entered upon the lien docket of the City of Albany, Oregon, and that the Recorder be and he is hereby directed, to give notice to the owners or reputed owners of said property of the assessment of said costs upon said properties above described for the amounts so made; and if said sum is not paid within ten days after the giving and service of said notice, that the Recorder of the City shall issue a warrant for the collection of said sum directed to the City Marshal to forthwith levy upon and sell the hereinabove described property as provided by law.

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Section 3: - This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
