A Bill for an Ordinance authorizing the building
of construction of an 8-inch vitrified terra cotta pipe lateral
sewer through the center of Block No. 52 & 45 in Hackleman's
second addition to the City of Albany, and directing the
Mayor and Records of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter
into a contract on the part of the City of Albany for the
construction of an 8-inch vitrified terra cotta pipe lateral
sewer through and across the following described property
as beginning at a point which is 141 feet North 81'
45' East of the Northeast corner of Block No. 52 in Hackle-
man's second addition to the City of Albany, Linn
County, Oregon, and running thence southwesterly
to a point on the East boundary line of said Block
No. 52, said point being equally distant from the
Northeast and Southeast corners of said Block 52, and
running thence westerly through the center of said
Block 52, and across Hill Street and westerly along
the center line of Block No. 45 in Hackleman's second
addition to the said City of Albany, to a connection
with the Madison Street sewer now laid and constructed
in Madison Street in the said City of Albany, Oregon,
and to construct said sewer at the cost and expense
of the several owners and holders of lots and parts
of lots abutting on and through the line of the proposed
lateral sewer as hereinabove described and to be
benefitted, thereby.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:
Section 1: That there shall be built and constructed
an 8-inch vitrified terra cotta pipe lateral sewer through
and across the following described property, to-wit:
Beginning at a point which is 141 feet North 81'
45' East of the Northeast Corner of Block No. 52 in Hack-
leman's second addition to the City of Albany, Linn
County, Oregon, and running thence southwesterly
to a point on the East boundary line of said Block
No. 52, said point being equally distant from the
Northeast corner and the Southeast corner of said Block
52, and running thence westerly through the center
of said block 52, and across Hill Street, and westerly
along the center line of Block No. 45 in Hackleman's
second addition to the said City of Albany, to a
connection with the Madison Street Sewer now laid

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and constructed in Madison Street in the said City of Albany, Oregon, and that the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon be and they are hereby authorized, directed and empowered to enter into and sign on the part of the City of Albany, written articles of agreement for the construction and laying of said 8-inch vitrified terra cotta pipe lateral sewers through and across the following described property:

Beginning at a point which is 141 feet north $81^{\circ} 45'$ East of the Northeast Corner of Block No. 52, in Haklaman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, and running thence Southwesterly to a point on the East boundary line of said Block No. 52, said point being equally distant from the Northeast Corner and the Southeast Corner of said Block 52, and running thence westerly through the center of said Block 52, and across Hill Street, and westerly along the center line of Block No. 45 in Haklaman's Second Addition to the said City of Albany, to a connection with the Madison Street Sewer now laid and constructed in Madison Street in the said City of Albany, Oregon.

That the cost of constructing and laying of said lateral sewer, be assessed to the several owners and holders of lots and parts of lots and parcels of land abutting on and through the line of the proposed lateral sewer, which is described as follows to-wit:

Beginning at a point which is 141 feet north $81^{\circ} 45'$ East of the Northeast Corner of Block No. 52, in Haklaman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, and running thence Southwesterly to a point on the East boundary line of said Block No. 52, said point being equally distant from the Northeast Corner and the Southeast Corner of said Block 52, and running thence westerly through the center of said block, 52, and across Hill Street, and westerly along the center line of Block No. 45, in Haklaman's Second Addition to the said City of Albany, to a connection with the Madison Street Sewer now laid and constructed in Madison Street in the said City of Albany, Oregon, to be benefited by said lateral sewer at their respective interests may appear, provided that said contract

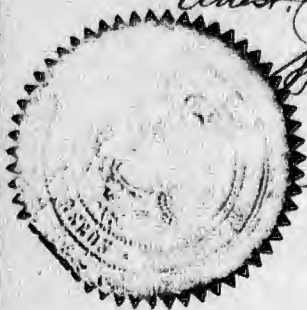
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shall not be entered into, and such articles of agreement signed by the Mayor and Recorder on the part of the City of Albany, until after proposals for the construction of said lateral sewer has been advertised for in the manner provided by the City Charter and Ordinances of said City regulating and awarding, all contracts, and bids have been received and considered by the Council and the contract awarded by the Common Council of the City of Albany, and the cost and expense for the construction of said lateral sewer is fixed and determined.

Section 2:- This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
