ORDINANCE NO 375

Passed by the Council June 9th 1913

Ord No. 375

An ordinance to regulate, restrain and prohibit the keeping of dogs or dogs by any person or persons within the City limits.

The people of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:-

Section 1 - Every person owning or keeping a dog or dogs within the City limits of the City of Albany shall pay an annual license of \$2.00 on each and every male dog or charged bitch or owned or kept - and on each uncharged bitch \$1.00.

Said license shall be paid to the City Recorder on or before the 1st day of the month following the date of obtaining or receiving within the city limits the said dog or dogs for the period of one year from the date of having such license.

Section 2 - It shall be the duty of the Recorder to keep in a well-bound book, kept in his office for that purpose, a record of all such licenses issued by him; the name of the person to whom issued and in name, color and description of the dog for which the license shall be issued and the date of the payment thereof and the date of the expiration of the license to keep said dog or dogs within the City limits of the City of Albany.

Section 3 - It shall be the duty of the Recorder to give to the City Pound Master at the end of each month a list of the names of all persons who have license to keep within the city limits a dog or dogs together with a description of each dog so licensed to be kept by such person or persons within the City.

Section 4 - The provisions of this ordinance shall be construed to apply to all kinds of dogs, both male and female, as provided for in Section 1 of this ordinance provided that it shall be unlawful for the owner of any bitch or female dog to allow such female dog to rub at horse when in heat, unless the license shall have been paid as provided in this ordinance.

Section 4: - This ordinance shall not apply to any dog while accompanied by or following its owner or master, provided said master or owner does not reside within the limits of said city.

Section 5: - Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance or failing or refusing to pay the license as provided in this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00 or be imprisoned in the City Jail not less than two days nor more than 25 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

Section 7: - The provisions of this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after 30 days after its approval by the Mayor.
