ORDINANCE NO. 378

An Ordinance regulating the driving and moving of stock through the public streets and alleys of the city of Albany, providing the manner in which the same may be moved, and punishment for violation thereof.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:-

Section I:- It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to drive or move any cows, pigs or hogs, cattle or other animals through any public street or alley within the City of Albany, Oregon, without having control of said animal or animals with reins or ropes or other fastenings and in the hands of some person sufficiently able to manage and control said animal or animals, within the following described district in said city, to-wit:-

Commencing at the intersection of Eighth and Vine Streets thence northerly along Vine Street to the Willamette River thence down the Willamette river to Thurston Street thence southerly and westerly along the center of the Santiam canal to Vine Street, the place of beginning.

Provided however that this ordinance shall not apply to persons driving or moving stock for market or transportation through said district laboring described and in charge of a competent herder.

Section II:- It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to drive or move any stock or animals through any public street or alley within the City of Albany for market, transportation, or other purpose without being in charge of a competent herder, or to permit or allow the same to trespass or go upon the premises of any person, unless the owners of such stock or animals shall have first obtained permission of the owners or tenant of said premises.

Section III:- Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court shall be fined not less than \$500 nor more than \$1000 or shall be imprisoned in the City Jail not less than two days nor more.

Section IV: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.

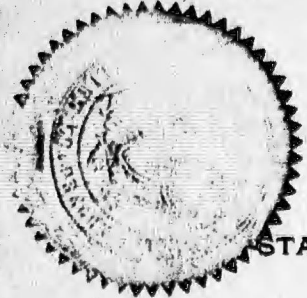
