

ORDINANCE No. 392.

An ordinance to amend Section 2 of an ordinance No 374 of the City of Albany, Oregon entitled "an ordinance providing for the material to be used in and the manner of constructing sidewalks on First Street from the East side of Washington Street to the East side of Baker Street and on Second Street from the West side of Ferry Street to the East side of Lyon Street, and on Third ^{and Fourth} Streets from the West side of Ferry Street to the East side of Lyon Street, and on Ferry, Broadalbin, Elsworth and Lyon Streets from First to Second Streets and on Ferry, Broadalbin, Elsworth and Lyon Streets from Second to Fourth Streets in the City of Albany, Oregon; and providing further for the maintenance of uniform curb lines within the said City and for specific authority for repairing and building sidewalks and curbs, and for penalties for the violation of the terms of this ordinance and matters kindred thereto" approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany on the 15th day of April 1903.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:-

Section 1:- That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 374 of the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, entitled "An ordinance providing for the material to be used, in and the manner of constructing sidewalks on First Street from the East side of Washington Street to the East side of Baker Street and on Second Street from the West side of Ferry Street to the East side of Lyon Street, and on Third and Fourth Streets from the West side of Ferry Street to the East side of Lyon Street and on Ferry, Broadalbin, Elsworth and Lyon Streets, from First to Second Streets and on Ferry, Broadalbin, Elsworth and Lyon Streets from Second to Fourth Streets, in the City of Albany, Oregon, and providing further for the maintenance of uniform curb lines within the said city and for specific authority for repairing and building sidewalks and curbs and for penalties for the violation of the terms of this ordinance and matters kindred thereto" approved on the 15th day of April 1903, be amended to read as follows:-

Section 2:- Along the front of the sidewalks provided for in Section 1. of this ordinance shall be placed a curb

of artificial stone or cement twelve feet from and parallel with the front line of the lot along which said sidewalk is constructed, and said curb shall not be less than six inches wide and not less than eighteen inches deep, and each section of such curb shall not be less than five feet in length, and said sidewalk, if constructed out of cement and concrete shall consist of eight parts of gravel and one part of cement for the base thereof and the top dressing shall not be less than three fourths inches thick and composed of fifty percent of sand and fifty percent of cement and with one fourth inch slope to the foot from the inside to the curb of said sidewalk and at the street corners the same to be rounded to conform to the quadrant of a circle with a 30-inch radius and at the outside corners at the alleys to be rounded to conform to the quadrant of a circle with a 24-inch radius.

Section 2:—This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
