An ordinance to establish the grade of First Street
between the East line of Harrison Street and the West
line of Denver Street in the City of Albany; and to
repeal all ordinances and parts of ordinances in
conflict herewith;

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The established grade of First Street between the
East line of Harrison Street and the West line of Denver Street in the
City of Albany, shall be in conformity with the survey and plat thereof
made by J. A. Warner, City Engineer, and filed in the office of the Recorder
of the City of Albany on the 14th day of March 1905.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict
herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in
force from and after its approval by the Mayor.
