Establishing grade of Cleveland, Denver and Geary Streets.

Ord 419 An ordinance establishing the grade of Cleveland, Denver
Establishing and Geary Streets, in Bryant's Addition to the City of Albany,
grade of between Scio road and the railroad track of the Southern Pacific
Cleveland, Company.

Denver + The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:-
Geary Sts Sec. 1. That the grade of Cleveland, Denver and Geary
Streets, in Bryant's Addition to the City of Albany, extending

from Scio (Dunthorn) road northward to the railroad track
of the Southern Pacific Company be and the same is hereby
established to conform to the survey and plat thereof made
by J. U. Warner, City Engineer, and filed in the office of
the City Recorder on the 12th day of June, 1906.

Sec 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict
herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from
and after its approval by the mayor.
