

## ORDINANCE NO. 460

## Contract for paving First Street

An Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany to enter into a contract with the Warren Construction Company for the improvement of First Street in said City from the East curb line of Washington Street to the W curb of Lyon Street.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Whereas, by Ordinance No. 452 of the City of Albany, Oregon passed by the Council on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1908 and approved by the Mayor on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1908, it was ordered that the following street of said City of Albany, to-wit:

First Street in said City from the East curb line of Washington Street to the West curb line of Lyon Street be improved as follows:-

- First. By grading the street to the proper sub-grade.
- Second. By paving the roadway of said street full width, with full intersections, with Bitulithic pavement.
- Third. By constructing artificial stone curbs.
- Fourth. By constructing curb side walks.
- Fifth. By laying and constructing Bitulithic leaders.
- Sixth. By constructing inlets.
- Seventh. By constructing catch basins.
- Eighth. By laying vitrified sewer pipe.

Said improvement to be made according to the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer when on file with the City Recorder of said City.

And whereas, it was provided in said Ordinance that the Recorder of said City give notice for bids for the making of said improvement in the manner provided by law and by said ordinance.

And whereas, after due notice and advertisement for bids, made and given by the City Recorder of said City according to law and the ordinance last aforesaid, to-wit, on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1908, the Warren Construction Company, a corporation, of Portland, Oregon presented to the Council its bid for making said proposed improvement, which bid was made in due form and in conformity with all the conditions



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imposed by law and by the Council, by which said bid said Warren Construction Company proposed to furnish all material and implements and perform the labor necessary to make the above described improvement for the following named prices:

Excavation, per cubic yard.	\$ .75
Bituminous foundation, per cubic yard	3.00
Bituminous surface, price per square yard	2.00
Embankment price per cubic yard	.20
Inlets, price per each	12.50
Catch basins, price per each	25.00
Rain Pipe, 6 inch, price per lineal foot	.70
Bituminous headers, price per lineal foot	.40

And whereas, said Warren Construction Company was the lowest responsible bidder for said proposed work, and said bid was the lowest and best bid therefor.

Section 1. That the said bid of said Warren Construction Company, for said improvement of said above described street be and the same is hereby accepted. And the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized to enter into a contract, in writing, with the said Warren Construction Company for the making of said improvement, as aforesaid, on behalf of the City, upon the terms mentioned in said bid, said contract to provide further, that the work of said improvement shall commence within thirty days after the signing of said contract, and to be prosecuted with such vigor that all the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the first day of July, 1909; and that the City of Albany shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of ten Dollars per day for each and every day the work is delayed beyond the specified time, and that the said Warren Construction Company furnish a bond in the sum of \$4,000.00 to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, having as surety, some surety company authorized to do business in the State of Oregon, conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of the Warren Construction Company, and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claims or liens for labor, work or materials in the part of any person arising out of said contract.

Section 2. Whereas, the public health and safety



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requires that work be commenced and said proposed improvement at an early date, and before the winter rains render it impossible to properly perform the same, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor
