An Ordinance Amending Section eight of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning offenses and disorderly conduct, defining what shall constitute the same and providing for the punishment thereof" passed by the Council May 3<sup>rd</sup> 1887. Approved by the Mayor May 13<sup>th</sup> 1887

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That section eight of an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Concerning offenses and disorderly conduct, defining what shall constitute the same and providing for the punishment thereof" passed the Council May 3<sup>rd</sup> 1887. approved by the Mayor May 13<sup>th</sup> 1887. be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 8. That any person or persons who shall fire off or discharge any ordinary gun, pistol, rifle or other fire arm within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, or shall ignite, fire or explode, or cause to be fired or exploded, any fire cracker, bomb, torpedo or other fire or detonating works of any description whatever within said City, shall, upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court of said City, be punished by a fine of not less than five nor more than fifty dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail not less than two days nor more than twenty five days, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of said Court; provided that the Mayor may permit, upon national holidays and other festive days the firing of guns or pistols for purposes deemed by him to be necessary or expedient within said City; and provided, that the Mayor may permit persons to fire off or explode firecrackers not more than one and a half inches in length, and not over one quarter of an inch in diameter, at such places in said City as he may specify.
