

Relating to Surplus, First Contract on Street Paving.

An ordinance declaring a surplus on account of street paving by the Warren Construction Company, on their first contract on the following named streets, to wit: -
First Street from the East curb line of Wash- ington Street to the West curb line of Lyon Street and on Ferry, Broadalbin and Ellsworth streets from the South line of First Street to the North curb line of Second Street, and directing that a warrant issue to the person or persons who pay such surplus in the payment of their assessments as owners of the real estate abutting upon said streets so improved, for the proportionate share of such surplus, and to declare an emergency.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a surplus of seven percent where- by ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the first four contracts entered into by the City of Albany with the Warren Construction Company for the improvement of First Street from the East curb line of Washington Street and the West curb line of Lyon Street, and on Ferry, Broadalbin and Ellsworth Streets from the South line of First Street to the North curb line of Second Street, of the sum assessed for the making of said improvement on each parcel of property included in said contracts, and in favor of each of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon and heretofore assessed for making such improvement and entered upon the Docket of Taxes of the City of Albany, Oregon.

Section 2. The Recorder of said City is hereby directed to draw warrants on the City Treasurer of said City in favor of the following named persons and owners of such various parcels of real estate in sum hereinafter to wit:

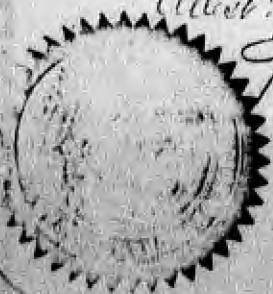
