

ORDINANCE No. 518

Relating to the purchase of Fire Hose.

An Ordinance authorizing the purchase of Fire
Hose and providing for the payment thereof.

The people of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:-

Section 1. - That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany
be, and they are hereby authorized to enter into a written
contract on behalf of the City of Albany, with the Fabric
Fire Hose Company, A. G. Long, general agent, Portland
Oregon for the purchase of 500 feet of "Patrol Fire Hose"
at \$1.00 per foot, coupled in sections, each 50 feet long,
complete with automatic expensing ring couplings,
delivered F. O. B. at Albany, Oregon.

And that upon the delivery and acceptance of
the same, the Recorder be, and he is hereby authorized
and directed to draw a warrant upon the Treasurer
for the payment of the said purchase price.

Section 2, Whereas, this being an Ordinance
ratifying a contract for the payment of money owing
by the City, an emergency is hereby declared
to exist and this Ordinance shall take effect
as in full force from and after its approval by
the Mayor.
