

Ord 697

An ordinance declaring a surplus on account of certain improvements on the alley in said city running through blocks numbered sixteen (16), seventeen (17) and eighteen (18), and directing the Recorder of the City of Albany is place to the credit of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of said alley heretofore assessed and entered of record in the dacket of city liens in the City of Albany, Oregon, for making such improvements, their proportionate share of such surplus.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That a surplus is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract entered into by and between the City of Albany, Oregon and Warren Construction Company for the improvement of the alley in said city running through blocks numbered sixteen (16), seventeen (17) and eighteen (18) and in favor of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of said alley heretofore assessed for making such improvement.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to enter in the Docket of City liens in the Surplus column thereof, a credit upon the several amounts heretofore assessed and entered therein to defray the cost of the improvement of said alley, said surplus being in favor of the following named persons, owners or reputed owners of such various parcels of real estate and in sums as follows, to-wit:
