An ordinance to repeal ordinance No. 419 of the City of Albany, entitled "An ordinance to regulate the cutting and raising of telegraph, electric and other wire wires for the purpose of repairing buildings, structures and edifices in the City of Albany," passed by the Council June 9, 1907, approved June 22, 1907.

Be it enacted by the City of Albany as follows:

Section 1. That ordinance No. 419 of the City of Albany, entitled "An ordinance to regulate the cutting and raising of telegraph, electric and other wire wires for the purpose of repairing buildings, structures and edifices in the City of Albany," passed by the Council June 9, 1907, approved June 22, 1907, be and the same hereby is repealed.

Enacted in the presence of the Council as aforesaid, and in view of the fact that the existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and emergency exists and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the approval of the Mayor.
